

INTERNAL TRANSFER of MATERIAL

The purpose of this document is to provide a record of transfer of biological material and to memorialize your agreement to the following terms regarding your use of samples obtained from the Indiana Biobank (IB),

- 1. You may not distribute the samples to others or use the samples for research other than in the research proposal approved by the IB.
- 2. By accepting any specimens from the IB, you agree to return all raw digital data, such as that generated by SNP arrays, gene expression arrays, proteomics, metabolomics from any experiments conducted with specimens acquired from the IB. The IB will make these data available to other researchers.
- 3. The raw data will be returned to the IB: (a) on the date that the results of the research enters the public domain through publication, or (b) on the date that the patent application is published, or (c) in the event that data is not published, 6 months following the completion of your experiments using the specimens. The deadline for return of data to the IB may be extended following a written justification approved by the IB.
- 4. You are required to acknowledge the contribution of samples from the Indiana Biobank in any and all oral and written presentations and publications with the following language:

"This [(publication was made possible) (project was supported), or (project was funded)], in part, with support from the Indiana Biobank and the Indiana Clinical and Translational Sciences Institute funded, in part by Award Number UL1TR002529 from the National Institutes of Health, National Center for Advancing Translational Sciences, Clinical and Translational Sciences Award. The content is solely the responsibility of the authors and does not necessarily represent the official views of the National Institutes of Health."
